Henry Rindick, Nathaniel Francis, Edward B. Eaton, Guthbert B. Barkner and Joseph T. Hite are appointed commissioners to superintend the election at the crop keys for the election of a delegate for this county in the next legislature of Virginia. And it is ordered that the commissioners do the election conducted fairly and impartially and according to law.

On the motion of James H. Hanger. Ordered that Edwards Batts who is hereby appointed special commissioner for the purpose do state, settle and adjust the said Hanger's account with said Harrison Lewis estate and make report thereof to Court.

On the motion of Odum Harrison. Ordered that William H. Jones, who is hereby appointed special commissioner for the purpose do state, settle and adjust an account of said Harrison's administration on William H. Harrison estate and make report thereof to Court.

On motion of Guthbert B. Barkner. Ordered that Edwards Batts trustee for Robert Bassett and children pay said Barkner twenty two dollars the amount of his account found
