Benjamin Williamson, Thomas L. Turner, Odum B. Glend, William A. Jones & Howell Bass are appointed commissioners to superintend the election at Jones' barn near the flat swamp, and
Henry Rindick, Nathaniel Francis, Edmund Beaton, Gathbert D. Baskin and Joseph T. Tate are appointed commissioners to superintend the election at the crop keys for the election of a delegate for this county in the next legislature of Virginia. And it is ordered that the commissioners so the election conducted fairly and impartially and according to law.

On the motion of James H. Hanger. Ordered that Edwards Batts who is hereby appointed special commissioner for the purpose do state, settle and adjust the said Indenture &c as directed in said Catherine Lanes estate and make report thereof to Court.

On the motion of Odum Harrison. Ordered that William A. Jones, who is hereby appointed special commissioner for the purpose do state, settle and adjust an account of the said Harrison's administration or William A. Harrison's estate and make report thereof to Court.

On motion of Gathbert D. Baskin. Ordered that Edwards Batts trustee for Robert Baskin and children pay said Baskin twenty two dollars the amount of his account found
