of two hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining

Emery among others of them, being sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose
do appraise all the personal estate of John Reville de? and return the appraisement

services of said apprentice the sum of two dollars except for the last year, for that year
paying \$18. to be paid to the apprentice.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
