In the nation of lands 10 acres also under oak and together with Richard Dardon and Thomas D. Worrell his securities intend will and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two hundred dollars conditioned at the law do res cert. fide & granted him for attorney letters of administration on the estate of John Revelle decd.

Ordered that Joseph B. Powell, Stephen T. Powell, Jonathan T. Griffin & Nathaniel Jones or any three of them being sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of John Revelle decd. and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

The Court doth appoint William Dardon guardian to James, Lucy & George W. Adams infants of Robert Adams decd. and therupon that David Williams Dardon with Wm. G. Peterson and George W. Griffin his securities intend will and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars conditioned according to law.

The Commissioners appointed to view and report the convenience and inconveniences that will result as well to individuals as to the public by turning the road on the south side of the Nelloway River at the Leffope Bridge this day made their report. Whereupon it is ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of this County to the next Court to consider the propriety of turning the embankment and bridge as recommended by said report.

The Registers of Fanning Peterson and Robert Arthur for wages were examined and certified to be truly made.

On motion of Eliot Dardon guardian of Margaret Lawrence he is allowed to expand twenty dollars of the principal of his ward's estate for her support if.

Ordered that the Masters of the poor bind Abraminda daughter of Matthew Jenkins free negro to D. B. Davis according to law the said master paying annually for the service of said apprentice the sum of two dollars except for the last year, for that year he pay \$16. to be paid to the apprentice.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
