On the motion of Archer P. Pond who made oath and together with Samuel B. Ellsby  
Security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars  
conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted hence for obtaining letters of adminis-  
tration on the estate of Francis B. Read dec'd in due form.

The Court doth adjudge John Griffis guardian of atoms John W. George & Eliza-  
bor G. and Mary Colbrille nephews of Muller & Brattle dec'd and claimants the  
said John Griffis with his attorneys & officers and Edward Tolles her security  
entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars condi-  
tioned as the law directs.

On the motion of Elizabeth Gale Ordered that she be exempt from the payment fine  
and costs on negro woman Sarah the being aged and infirm.

On the motion of Samuel Drury & James D. Mapenburg setting forth that they  
are bound in this Court as security for William D. Hood for his due and faithful  
administration on the estate of Benjamin Hancock dec'd and that they conceive themselves  
to be in danger of suffering damages by reason thereof and praying the Court for  
relief. It is ordered that the said William D. Hood be summoned to appear before  
the first day of the next term to show cause if any he can why he should not be liable to  
give the said Samuel Drury & James D. Mapenburg of good and lawful security according  
to law.

The prosecutor in present aff' d. D. having failed to prosecute a disputed bill  
between Thomas J. Dutton and Jonathan Parker. On motion of said Dutton it is  
ordered that the surveyor of this County with a jury do lay and prosecute the  
bounds so in dispute at the charge of the party against whom the right lies the  
bounds shall be determined and return such survey with the proceedings thereon  
to the next Court after the said survey shall be made.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
