On the motion of Archer P. Pond who made oath and together with Samuel B. Kelleher solemnly entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs testificants is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Francis B. Pond dec^d on due bond.

The Court doth assign John Griffin guardian of Anne, John W. George & Abigail to Lot and Mary Eldridge nephews of Walter B. Baillie dec^d and then gave the said John Griffin with David W. Griffin and Patrick Dole his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs.

On the motion of Elizabeth Tate. Ordered that she be exempt from the payment of fines and levies on negro woman Sarah she being aged and infirm.

On the motion of Samuel Drury & James D. Hapenbury telling forth that they are bound on this Court as security for William D. Hood for his due and faithful administration on the estate of Benjamin Hancock dec^d and that they conceive themselves to be in danger of suffering damages by causing thereof and praying the Court for relief. It is ordered that the said William D. Hood be summoned to appear here on the first day of the next term to show cause if any he can why he should not be released from the said Samuel Drury & James D. Hapenbury of good and lawful security according to law.

The proscutors in present of H. D. having failed to proscure a disputed bond between Thomas J. Poston and Jonathan Dardot. On motion of said Dardot is ordered that the lawyers of this County with a jury do lay and proscure the bonds herein dispute at the charge of the party against whom the right to each bonds shall be determined and return such survey with the proceedings thereon to the next Court after the said survey shall be made.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
