On the motion of Charles P. Ford for leave to open a new road leading from his house to Copeland road. The suit of ad quod dominum awarded at the last term not being executed. On the motion of the said Ford a new suit of ad quod dominum is awarded him to be executed on the day of August next, which will with the injunction to be taken in pursuance thereof be returned to the next term.

On the motion of Jonathan T. Griffin who made oath and together with Just. Barnes his security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Martha Brown, four negro, according to law.

Ordered that Jacob Barnes, R. B. Barrill, N. B. Cutler and William S. Barrill or any two of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Martha Brown, four, and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.
