An Account current and Commissioners report of James D Bryant's account

of this lot to the lowest bidder after the erection of the bridge over Herring Branch and
the said Scarbrough receive the same when completed and make report thereof to Court.

Mary Pond widow of Ambrold P Pond relinquished her right to the administration
of her deceased husband's estate in favor of William B Harwell and on the motion
of the said Harwell who made oath and together with James Harris, Robert Foster
Robertson Holt and Robert B Hollings his Sureties entered into and acknowledged a
bond in the sum of six thousand dollars conditioned at the law direct certificate
so granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of the said
Ambrold P Pond de^r in due form.

On the motion of Reed B Rivers one of the executors named in the last Will and Testament
of Henrietta T Pierce de^r heretofore pronounced recorded in this Court who made oath and
together with Patrick Dales, James Magat and G W Stevens his Sureties entered
into and acknowledged a bond in the sum of twelve thousand dollars conditioned
at the law direct certificate so granted him for claiming a portion of the land with
in due form.

or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for said purpose
to appear at all the present estate of Ambrold P Pond de^r and return the officers
