

An Account Current and Commissioner report of James D Boycott rendered forwads on Dudley Boycott estate was returned and ordered to be on town for expense.

On the motion of John T Howard Ordered that the account of his executor for expenses on Richard A Gellmore estate be recommended to the Commissioner who reported it for him to examine, on State and settle and make report to the Court with any action specially stated, demand pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

Ordered that the accounts of Joseph H Donnell, an amounting to \$117.50 and the other to \$12.25 be severally certified to the Auditor of public accounts for his examination and payment.

For reasons appearing to the Court Ordered that the Clerk deliver to John T Howard or his attorney in fact a bond returned by the Commissioner as his preparation of the sales of the lower bluns of John Woodcock dec<sup>d</sup>.

On the motion of Harrison B Moore Ordered that Commissioner Goodenough examine State and settle an account of said Moore's administration on the estate of the estate of Jonathan Moore dec<sup>d</sup> and make report thereof to Court.

The Commissioner heretofore appointed to let the valuation of the compensation and the extent of new bridges near Jerusalem this day made their report.

Ordered that James E Peters, Robert Renwick and Howell B. Scarborough may be of them let to the Court undertake the repairs of the bridge over Hornt swamp and the said Scarborough receive the same when completed and make report thereof to Court.

Mary Bond widow of Ambrose P Bond relinquished her right to the administration of her deceased husband's estate in favor of William B. Howell and on the motion of the said Howell who made oath and together with the James Harris, Robert Foster, Robertson Holt and Robert B. Rollins his sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of the said Ambrose P. Bond dec<sup>d</sup> in due form.

On the motion of Rev B Brown one of the executors named in the last will and testament of Hemanter J. Pierce dec<sup>d</sup> heretofore proved and recorded in this Court, who made oath and together with Patrick Dole, James Mayhew and S. A. W. Howard his sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of twelve thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said will in due form.

Ordered that Robertson Holt, Doremy Bond, Henry Freeman and Henry Brown or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose to appraise all the personal estate of Ambrose P. Bond dec<sup>d</sup> and return the appraisement under their hands to Court -
