

The last will and testament of Benjamin Bryant deceased was proved by the will of A H Hale and  
Cornelia Bryant the subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of James D.  
Bryant the aforesaid theron named who made unto me together with Alexander Myrick and Thomas  
R. Howell his subscribers entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars and  
therein as the law directs certificate is granted him for claiming a probate of the said will in due form.

The last will and testament of John Gardner deceased was proved by the will of Miles Williamson, Hardy  
Purvis and Charles Holland the subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the  
motion of Jose Cobb and John W Gardner the executors theron named who made unto me together  
with John Moore Jr and A. M. Howell their subscribers entered into and acknowledged a bond in the  
penalty of three thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted them for claiming  
a probate of the said will in due form.

Ordered that John Moore Jr, Meredithe Holland, Matthew Vaughan, J. C. Anthony & H. Howell among  
these of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appear with the  
personal and real estate of Jose Gardner deceased which may be to them produced or shown and return the appearance  
and enter their bonds to Court.

On the motion of Jacob Vick who made oath and together with Thomas R. Howell and James J.  
Davidson his subscribers entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars  
conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for claiming letters of administration on the  
estate of Jacob Vick deceased in due form.

Benjamin W. Barbaree who stands committed to the jail of this County for want of security upon  
the complaint of Louisa Barbaree his wife, against him for a breach of the peace, was brought into  
Court in custody of the jailor of this County. Whereupon Sunday certificates were sworn and examined  
and the said Louisa Barbaree making oath according to law and requiring security of the peace  
against the said Barbaree, and the said Benjamin W. Barbaree being fully heard, it is the opinion of  
the Court and accordingly ordered that the said Benjamin W. Barbaree enter into a recognizance  
himself in the sum of one hundred dollars with two sufficient securities in the sum of fifty dollars  
each, conditioned for his keeping the peace and being of good behaviour towards all the citizens of this  
Commonwealth, especially towards the said Louisa Barbaree for the term of twelve months from  
this day, and that the said Benjamin W. Barbaree do also pay the costs of this prosecution. And therefore  
he is remanded to jail until he enter into the said recognizance with sufficient security as aforesaid.

Benjamin W. Barbaree who stands committed to the jail of this County for the want of security upon the complaint of  
Benjamin O. Myrick against him for a breach of the peace, was brought into Court in custody of the jailor of this County.  
Whereupon Sunday certificates were sworn and examined and the said Barbaree making oath according to law and requiring  
security of the peace against the said Barbaree, and the said Barbaree being fully heard, it is the opinion of the  
Court and accordingly ordered that the said Benjamin W. Barbaree enter into a recognizance himself to be bound in  
the sum of one hundred dollars with two sufficient securities in the sum of fifty dollars each, conditioned for his keeping  
the peace and being of good behaviour towards all the citizens of this Commonwealth, especially towards the said Benja-  
min O. Myrick, for the term of twelve months from this day, and that he also pay the costs of this prosecution. And  
therefore he is remanded to jail until he enter into the said recognizance with sufficient security as aforesaid.
