This day this cause came on again to be heard on the papers previously read, and the report of James B. Merrill Special Commissioner and was argued by counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth approve, order and have that out of the moneys arising from the sale of the said tract of land the party first the expenses of the sale & then the debts which he has reported binding there, and remainder divide into three equal parts and assign one part to Simon Mages, assigner of James B. Merrill, one part to Margaret Gardner and the remaining part to Samuel Gardner.

The Decree was awarded at this last Court to transmit the Justices to this Court to consider the propriety of granting a new road from Tuckers Swamp Meetinghouse, across Swamps, intersecting the road leading from Southfield to Foxcroft, near the dwelling of Mr. Thomas Lewis, being returned located. The Court upon consideration of the report and all the circumstances, of the case do allow the said road to be laid subject to said Allen Edwards, James B. Vagabond, William R. Stephenson, Thomas Lewis, and James B. Blayton, any two of whom may act, an appointed Commissioners to lay to the level and build the bridge of the said road, and the erection of such bridges as they may deem necessary, that they execute the works when completed and make report thereof to the Court.

On the return of Jonathan Jordan. Ordered that Commissioner Shanks do examine, state and settle an additional account of Bonwell & Whitefields administration on Henry Mages estate and make report thereof to Court.

On the return of Robert G. Griffin. Ordered that Lillian R. Edwards also a bond appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose do state, settle and adjust said Griffins accounts proceedings on Benjamin Griffins estate and make report thereof to the Court.

John Davis Jr. is appointed surveyor of the road from Vickerville to the quaker meeting house well known of Jeremiah Sheppfield owned, and it is ordered that the said bonds do work thereof.

On the return of Lucy Stephens. Ordered that the estate of Mary Bille do be committed to the hands of Jacob Barnes Sheriff of this County for administration according to law.

On the return of Mary W. Bille. Ordered that Simon Griffin guardian of the persons of William B. Bille do pay to her the sum of five hundred dollars for the bond, education, clothing for said children as the proportion of one hundred and twenty five dollars for each child if it can be shown that same may be in his hands.
