This day this cause came on again to be heard on the hearing formerly had, and the report of James W. Mifflin Special Commissioner and was argued by counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge and determine that out of the money arising from the sale of the land tract of land he pay first the expenses of the sale & then the debts which he has reported being due and recoverable divided into three equal parts and give one part to Simon Mifflin spouse of James W. Gardner, one part to Margaret Gardner and the remaining part to Edmund Gardner.

The summons awarded at the last Court to summon the Justices to this Court to consider the property of sprung or new road from Beckers Bridge Middlebury horse soap branch intersecting the road leading from Smithfield to Jerusalem near the dwelling of old Mr. Thomas Mifflin being returned executed. On the motion of Lucy Johnson. Ordered that the estate of Mary Bittle be committed to the hands of Jacob Barnes Sheriff of this County for administration according to law.

On the motion of Mary H. Bittle. Ordered that Abram Griffis guardian of the affairs of Bittle & Bittle do^r pay to her the sum of five hundred dollars for the land, education, clothing &c of her children in the proportion of One hundred and twenty five dollars for each child, if less than that sum or more in her hands.
