

On the motion of Lewis Woodrill who made oath and together with Thomas B. Woodrill and Robert S. Barnes his sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of twenty five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Joseph Woodrill dec'd in due form.

Ordered that Richard Barrett, Alexander Mayhew, Jacob Barrett and Benjamin S. Barrett or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Joseph Woodrill dec'd and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

The Court doth assign Peter Parker guardian to Martha W. and Agnes S. Sells orphans of Joseph S. Sells and thereupon the said Peter Parker with Joseph B. Cole and Jacob B. Broughton his sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditioned according to law.

An account current of James Mayhew's administration on John Barrett's estate was returned and ordered to be one term for exceptions.

An account current of Davis Barrett's executorial proceedings on Nathan Poyer's estate was returned and ordered to be one term for exceptions.

Accounts of Amos W. Gardner's guardianship of Eben Williams & Charles Hawley were returned and ordered to be read.

On the motion of Wiley Lane who made oath, and together with Miles Farnham and Littleton R. Lane his sureties (who qualified as oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of the heirs of David Littleton dec'd in due form.

The last Will and testament of Temperance Hines dec'd was proved by the oaths of W. B. Willows, James W. Willows and Littleton R. Lane the subscribing witnesses and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of Richard Hines and John Hines the executors therein named who made oath and together with James S. Parsons and James S. Stephenson their sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted them for obtaining a probate of the said will in due form.

Ordered that Arthur A. Drury, Jesse Ballinger, Wiley Lane, and Benjamin Jones or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal and real estate of Temperance Hines dec'd, which may be to them produced or shown, and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

Ordered that the Overseers of the poor do bind Sally S. Bow a free girl of colour & her Barnes according to law, and that she pay the amount to be paid by said Barnes for the support of said girl at \$3. per annum from the time she attains seven years of age.
