ministration on the estates of the heirs of David Hartshorn deceased in the sum

The last Will and Testament of Temperance Hines deceased was proved by the will
of W. B. Willcox, James H. Willcox and Pittilton R. Lane the subscriber who
thinks and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of Richard Hines and John
Parsons and James T. Stephenson their sureties entered into and acknowledged
a bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs which
certificate is granted them for obtaining a probate of the said will in due form.

Ordered that Arthur A. Drury, Sept. Robbins, Wiley Lane, and George
Hines or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace
for that purpose do appropriate all the personal and real estate of Temperance
Hines deceased which may be to them produced or shown, and return the same
under their hands to Court.

Ordered that the Overseers of the Poor do bind Sally F. Bow a free girl of about 16
years according to law, and the said for the amount to be paid by said Bow for the
same to be paid at 93 per annum from the time the same came into the
hands of the said Court.
