In Chancery

This day this cause came on to be heard by consent on the bill, answer and exhibits and was argued by Counsel. On consideration the Court doth order, adjudge and decree that John Griffin who is hereby appointed a Special Commissioner of this Court, after advertising the time and place of sale for twenty days at the Court house and two or more public places in the vicinity of the said land in the bill mentioned proceed to sell the said land subject to the dower of Henry B. Biddle the widow of the said John B. Biddle, to the highest bidder, and that he receive so much or more as will pay the expenses of this decree, and for the balance of the proceeds of sale he take five equal bonds with good security payable in six months. And that he report to Court in order to a final decree.

For reasons appearing to the Court. Ordered that Levi Huntley be summoned to the next Court to show cause, if any he has, why the Defendants heretofore Smith Jones and Sarah Jones, free negroes, to him, the said Huntley should not be recorded.
