

Geo. Waller having made complaint to a Justice of the Peace for the County Court Denny Biddle his attorney was removing out of the County puriously or to abscond or conceal himself that the ordinary process of law could not be served upon him, and the said Justice having granted an attachment against the estate of the said Denny Biddle relinquent to this Court which has been levied upon his goods and chattels. The said Geo. Waller this day appeared by his attorney and the said Denny Biddle being solemnly called before me the Sheriff came James St. Omer Conner who claimed the property levied upon, and the said Geo. Waller and the said James St. Omer Conner appeared being fully heard it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the defendant the sum of ten dollars with interest from the 7<sup>th</sup> day of January 1847 till paid and his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended. And it is ordered that the defendant pay the said attachment after selling and delivering of the goods and chattels attached as aforesaid and satisfying the said judgment this day rendered upon attachment in favor of E. G. & J. P. Peper, C. D. Barnes, Benjamin St. Omer, Thompson O'Reilly, James H. Peper & Peter Edwards that happily the balance in satisfaction of this judgment and if any surplus should then remain return it to the defendant that the said officer is required to return to the Clerk's Office within thirty days after the said sale account and completed an account of the sale, specifying wherein the several articles sold, the persons to whom sold and the price thereof.

Motion carried. To the judgment given for the plaintiff on the said action the said James St. Omer Conner as aforesaid excepted and tendered his bill of exception, which bill was received, signed & sealed by the Court and ordered to be made a part of the record in this case.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next term.
