On the motion of Benjamin Ellis Ordered that Edward de Wolfe, trustee for Edward Evans and children pay to Benjamin Ellis seven dollars and fifty cents interest from 1st January 1839 the amount of his account.

The Court doth adjudge Benjamin E. Pope guardian to Sarah Ann Parker infant daughter of Richard Parker and therefore the said Benjamin E. Pope with Garrison & St. John severally entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars conditioned according to law.

Thomas H. Westbrook who is charged on suit by Mary E. Moore with being the father of her bastard child this day appeared in Court in discharge of his obligation and thereupon the said Mary E. Moore being sworn and examined and the said Thomas H. Westbrook by his attorney fully heard. On consideration whereof it is ordered that the said complaint be dismissed.

The Court doth adjudge wife J. Barkham guardian to William, Fanny, and Louis the nephews of Lazarus Jelks dec'd and therefore the said wife J. Barkham with Charles July and Joseph H. Barkham his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One Thousand dollars conditioned according to law.

The Court doth adjudge John M. Gorley guardian to C. Virginia Barnes option of the said Barnes dec'd and therefore the said John M. Gorley with Joseph L. Barkham & Joseph S. Bailey his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Ten dollars conditioned according to law.

On the motion of Nathaniel Francis. Ordered that Littleton R. Edwards who is hereby appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose, do State, take and adjust an account of said Francis' goods of Mary J. Smith and make report thereof to Court.

For reasons appearing to the Court Ordered that the Indentures by which certain land owned by Beville Daniel be and they are hereby transferred to Robert Raeford according to law.

On the motion of Nathaniel Francis setting forth that he is bound in this court as security for James A. Person for his guardianship of C. Virginia Barnes and that he conveys him to the said James A. Person to surround his estate to that cause if any be come into the said James A. Person to give the said Francis good and sufficient security according to law. Ordered that the said James A. Person appear in Court and the said Person and Francis being fully heard be considered by the Court that the said Person give the said Francis good and sufficient security according to law. And the said Person refusing to give the said Francis the said security be directed to make the duties and powers of the said Francis as guardian as aforesaid executed and carried out.

In cause appearing to the Court it is ordered that the Owners of the place to be held known as "the farm" to Joseph Branch pay wages according to law, and the Court fix the sum to be paid to said Branch at four dollars to be paid annually.
