On the motion of Benjamin Ellis Ordered that Edward de Wille trustee for Edward
Brent and children pay to Benjamin Ellis seven dollars and fifty cents with interest from
1st January 1839 the amount of his account.

The Court doth assign Benjamin C. Pope guardian to Sarah Ann Porter infant child
of Richard Porter and thereupon the said Benjamin C. Pope with Harrison & Pope
severally entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars
conditioned according to law.

Thomas A. Westbrooke who is charged on oath by Henry C. Moore with being the
father of her husband child this day appeared in Court on discharge of his obligation
and thereupon the said Henry C. Moore being sworn and examined and the said
Thomas A. Westbrooke by his attorney fully heard. On consideration thereof the Court
that the said complaint be dismissed.

The Court doth assign Jesse L. Barham guardian to William Fanny and Maria de
aprons of Sagarin de la de and thereupon the said Jesse L. Barham with John A. Gentry
and Joseph M. Barham his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of
One thousand dollars conditioned according to law.

The Court doth assign John M. Gentry guardian to C. Virginia Barnes orphan of the
Barnes de and thereupon the said John M. Gentry with Jesse L. Barham & Joseph A. Gentry
his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Ten dollars conditioned
to law.

On the motion of Nathaniel Francis. Ordered that Elizabeth R. Edwards who is hereby appointed
Special Commissioner for the purpose de State title and request an account of said Francis guardian
of Mary J. Powell and make report thereof to Court.

For reasons appearing to the Court Ordered that the Indentures by which Carter have entered
to David Daniel be and they are hereby transferred to Robert Crawford according to law.

On the motion of Nathaniel Francis setting forth that he is bound in this Court as surety of
James B. Perens for his guardianship of C. Virginia Barnes and that he consents himself to the
charges of suffering damages thereby and praying the Court for relief. Ordered that the said
James B. Perens be summoned to appear here instant to show cause if any he can why he should
not be ruled to give the said Francis good security lawfully according to law. Whereupon the said
James B. Perens appeared in Court and the said Barnes and Francis being fully heard it is
considered by the Court that the said James B. Perens give the said Francis good security
to law. And the said Perens refusing to give the said Francis the said security it is ordered
that the duties and powers of the said Perens as guardian as aforesaid be revoked and annulled.

For reasons appearing to the Court it is ordered that the Owners of the vessel de bark Brown de
five negroes to Jesse Branch five negroes according to law, and the Court fix the sum to be paid to the
said Branch at four dollars to be paid annually.
