

The Court doth assign Henry Kendrick, guardian to Benjamin & John & Peter nephews of James Pope deceased and thereupon the said Henry Kendrick with Benjamin & Peter and James & Peter his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of four thousand dollars conditioned according to law.

On the motion of Charles Leitch Ordered that William T. Girding one of the commissioners of this Court do state, settle and adjust an account of Robert Leitch guardianship of the persons of Robert & Anne Grace de^d and make report thereof to Court.

The last will and testament of James Gardner de^d was proved by the oath of Joseph Buckston and James Gardner two of the subscribing witnesses thereto and having been before proved by the oath of Joseph B. Buckston is ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of James B. Gardner one of the executors therein named who made oath and together with William B. Gardner and Wm. Bennett his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs satisfactorily granted him for (paying) a probate of the said Will on due proof. James Gardner the other executor named appeared in Court and refused to take upon himself the burden of the execution of the said Will.

Ordered that Timothy Dyer, Joseph B. Shawen and Laurence Shawen being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of James Gardner de^d and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

Be it remembered, that Solomon Shawen with Anthony M. Howell, John T. Wade, John S. Bishop and James Gardner his securities have in Court severally acknowledged themselves to be indebted unto the Commonwealth of Virginia that is to say the said Solomon Shawen in the sum of One hundred dollars and the said Howell Wade Bishop and Gardner in the sum of twenty five dollars each, of their respective goods and chattels lands and tenements to be levied and to the use of the Commonwealth to be recovered. Yet upon this condition that if the said Solomon Shawen shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour towards the Commonwealth and all its citizens more especially towards Robert G. Edwards of this County for the term of twelve months from this day then this recognizance to be voided else to remain in full force.

Joseph Ingham who stands bound by recognizance for his appearance here to answer the complaint of John Wade against him, this day appeared in Court in discharge of his recognizance and being heard it is ordered that the said complaint be dismissed.

On motion of Joseph B. Powell Ordered that William B. Thoms one of the commissioners of this Court do state, settle and adjust an account of said Powell's guardianship of William & P. Powell and make report thereof to Court.

On the motion of William Stephenson guardian of Richard P. Kelly Edward ordered that he be allowed to expend twenty five dollars out of each of his wards estate for their support. &c.

An account of Augustus P. Jones executor's proceedings on William B. Powell's estate was returned and ordered to be on time for exceptions.

Ordered that the present of the end of which Edward B. Campbell is surrogat be extended from August to Brown Vinyards and the house of Brown Vaughan, Thomas Vaughan, Cecelia Smith, William Vaughan
