

The Court doth adjudge Henry Gardner, guardian to Benjamin f and Clark & Sons espouse of James Poynter deceased and thereupon the said Henry Gardner with Benjamin C Poynter and Garrison C Poynter his securities entred into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of four thousand dollars conditioned regard
ing to law.

On the motion of Charles Leigh Ordered that William T Gedney one of the commissioners of the court do make settle and adjust an account of Edward Leigh's guardianship of the infant of Robert T Mas-
sey dec'd and make report thereof to Court.

The last will and testament of Jason Gardner dec'd was proved by the oaths of Joseph Beckton and Daniel Parker two of the subscribers witnesses thereto and having been before proved by the oaths of wife to
Julia A Johnson is ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of James R Gardner one of the executors therein named who made oath and together with Nelson P Gardner and Henry Crumell his securities entred into and
acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One Thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs sufficient
granted him for drawing a probate of the said Will no sum found. Lewis Gardner the other Commissioner
named appeared in Court and refused to take upon himself the burden of the execution of the said Will.

Ordered that Dorothy Dark, wife to Johnson and Lawrence Johnson being first duly sworn before
a Justice of the Peace further required to appear all the personal estate of Jason Gardner dec'd and
return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

the Commonwealth of Virginia that is to say the said Eleazar Johnson in the sum of One Thousand
dollars, and the said Powell Peale Peale and Gardner in the sum of twenty five dollars each,
of their respective goods and chattels lands and tenements to be levied and to the use of the com-
monwealth to be considered. Yet upon the condition that of the said Eleazar Johnson shall keep the peace and
be of good behaviour towards the Commonwealth and all its citizens more especially towards Robert E
Delwards of this County for the term of twelve months from the day when this recognizance to be under-
the seal in full force.

Elizabt Synder who stands bound by recognizance for his appearance here to answer the complaint of Jas
Vick against him, this day appeared in Court in discharge of his recognizance and being bound it is ordered
that the said complaint be dismissed.

On motion of Joseph B Powell. Ordered that William D Guards one of the commissioners of the court do
state, settle and adjust an account of said Powell's guardianship of William N Powell and make report thereof
to Court.

On the motion of William Stephenson guardian of Harriett Polly Johnson ordered that he be allowed
to expend twenty five dollars out of each of his ward's estate for their support. ^{if}

An account of Augustus Pope's escheat proceedings on Holliday Drayton's estate were returned and
ordered to be an issue for judgment.

Ordered that the present of the sum of which Edward C Cromwell is charged be deducted from Edward C
Cromwell Vaughan and the hands of David Vaughan, Thomas Vaughan, Josiah Smith, Holling Vaughan
