

Ordered that the Clerk deliver to L. Abner R. Edwards administrator de bonis non of Jesse Woodard, de^d the bonds and money advanced by the Commissioner for the estate of the said Jesse Woodard from the sale of the diverse negroes of John Woodard.

On the motion of A. M. Sebrill. Ordered that L. Abner R. Edwards who is hereby appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose de statu, settle and adjust an account of said Sebrill's administration on John J. Douthett estate and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that the personal of the road of which Matthew Vaughan is surveyor be extended from Monroe to Orren Vaughans and that the bonds of Orren Vaughans, Josiah Smith, William Vaughan, Henry Foster and Regent Holland and the bonds that have usually worked thereon do work on the road of which the said Vaughan is surveyor.

On the motion of Richard A. Urquhart. Ordered that William B. Link who is appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose de statu, settle and adjust an account of said Urquhart's administration on George B. Hollomans estate and make report thereof to Court.

Calvin J. Stephenson is appointed surveyor of the road leading from Southway to the lightwood bridge in the town of Hartwell County who has received, and it is ordered that the usual bonds do work thereon.

Peter L. Beckwith the executor named in the last will and testament of John Simmons, de^d appeared in Court and referred to take upon himself the burden of the execution of the said will. Whereupon on the motion of William J. Holt who made oath and together with J. R. Edwards and A. M. Howell his brother entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Edwin Simmons, de^d with his will annexed as de fact.

Ordered that John James Thomas Simmons, Jesse Little and David Holt or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the peace for that purpose de affirmare all the personal estate of Edwin Simmons, deceased and under the appointment under their hands to Court.

Edward C. Crumpler is appointed surveyor of the road from Monroe to Barto bridge and it is ordered that the usual bonds do work thereon.

On the motion of Lenny Holt. Ordered that she be exempt from the payment of taxes and levies for her negro woman Lenny in future, having aged and infirm.

On the motion of Lenna Howell. Ordered that she be exempt from the payment of taxes and levies on negro woman Kellany in future, she being aged and infirm.
