On the motion of Nathl. Debrell. Ordered that Littleton R. Edwards who is duly appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose de state settle and adjust an account of said Debrell's administration on John J. Drakes estate and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that the proceeds of the road of which Matthew Vaughan is manager be extended from Monroe to Drew Vaughans and that the hands of Drew Vaughn, Thomas Vaughn, Joseph Smith, Hillary Blumpton, Henry Foster and Bryant Holland and the hands that have usually worked thereto do work on the road of which the said Vaughan is manager.

On the motion of Richard A. Vaughan. Ordered that William D. Stark be appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose de state settle and adjust an account of said Vaughan's administration on George W. Bellows estate and make report thereof to Court.

Calvin J. Stephenson is appointed Surveyor of the road leading from Scrubby to the light wood bridge in the name of Hartwell Bailey who has named, and is ordered that the usual hands do work thereon.

Peter D. Becknow the executor named in the last will and testament of John Simmons deceased appeared in Court and refused to take upon himself the burden of execution of the said will. Whereupon on the motion of William J. Debrell he made oath and together with L.R. Edwards and A.M. Howell his minister entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars indorsed as the law directs certifying is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Edwin Simmons deceased with his will annexed or as per

Ordered that John Evans, Thomas Simmons, John Little and Daniel Howell many three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the peace for that purpose do administer all the personal estate of Edwin Simmons deceased and stand the apprenticeship under their hands to Court.

Edward C. Crumples is appointed Surveyor of the road from Elmore to Park City it is ordered that the usual hands do work thereon.

On the motion of Penny Holt. Ordered that she be except from the payment of taxes and tuis for her negro man Davy in future, being aged and infirm.

On the motion of Lewis Howell. Ordered that she be except from the payment of taxes and tuis for her negro woman Cleary in future, she being aged and infirm.
