For Howell Harris, William A. Davis, Thomas P. Morris, Jacob E. Peters, Nathaniel Evans & John J. P. Pennington the Court were unanimous.

For Peter J. Holmes, Samuel D. Hale, William A. Hammill, Gordon G. Griffen, John Cobb, William J. Debrell and Jonathan Gardner the Court were unanimous.

The Court then proceeded to vote between Henry Hendred, Merit J. Davis, Nathan D. Bryant and Elijah Innes which two of them should be recommended and the vote stood as follows.

For Henry Hendred the votes were G. A. W. Stevens, Robert G. Griffen, Francis T. Ridley, W. Nickerson, Samuel Dowry, Jacob Barrett, Doug E. Pope, Alexander Myrick, Lemuel P. Nickerson and James Magot.

For Merit J. Davis the votes were G. A. W. Stevens, Robert G. Griffen, A. Myrick & John Parker.

For Nathan D. Bryant the votes were W. Nickerson, N. M. Schell, Samuel Dowry, Doug E. Pope, James D. Bryant and Thomas D. Morris.

For Elijah Innes the votes were F. T. Ridley, William D. Head, Thomas Ridley, N. M. Debrell, Jacob Barrett, James D. Bryant, John Parker, Thomas D. Morris, W. Nickerson and James Magot. Henry Hendred having a majority, the Court proceeded to vote which of the other three should be recommended and the vote stood as follows.

For Merit J. Davis the votes were G. A. W. Stevens, Robert G. Griffen and Alexander Myrick.

For Nathan D. Bryant the votes were Thomas Ridley, W. Nickerson, N. M. Debrell, Samuel Dowry, Jacob Barrett, Doug E. Pope and James D. Bryant.

For Elijah Innes the votes were F. Ridley, William D. Head, John Parker, Thomas D. Morris, W. Nickerson and James Magot.

The Court then proceeded to take the vote between Richard Barrett, William A. Mafusburg, Seth D. Williams and Abram Gardner, which two of them should be recommended - the vote stood as follows.

For Richard Barrett the votes were George A. W. Stevens, Thomas Ridley, Francis T. Ridley, William D. Head, Nicholas M. Schell, Samuel Dowry, Benjamin E. Pope, Alexander Myrick, John D. Bryant, Thomas D. Morris and W. Nickerson.

For William A. Mafusburg the votes were G. A. W. Stevens, Francis T. Ridley, Thomas Ridley, W. Nickerson, N. M. Schell, Samuel Dowry, Doug E. Pope, Alexander Myrick, James D. Bryant, John Parker, Thomas D. Morris and James Magot.

For Seth D. Williams the votes were Robert G. Griffen, John Parker, James Magot, Jacob Barrett, Whereupon Howell Harris, William A. Davis, Thomas J. Durst, James Collier, Nathaniel Evans, John J. P. Pennington, Peter J. Holmes, Samuel D. Hale, William A. Hammill, Gordon G. Griffen, John Cobb, William J. Debrell, Jonathan Gardner, Henry Hendred, Nathan D. Bryant, Richard Barrett and William A. Mafusburg are recommended to the Governor of the Commonwealth as fit and proper persons to be commissioners Justices of the Peace for this county.

Ordered that Thomas D. Morris, Henry Blair and Richard Durst, any two of whom may be let to the lowest undertaker the repair of the Cypress bridge, receive the same when completed and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next term.
