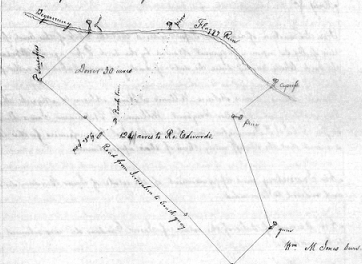

The Commissioners appointed to sell to Margaret Bell her share in the lands of her deceased husband Benjamin Bell this day made their report which is compared and ordered to be recorded.



Pursuant to the order of Court, herewith annexed, we the within named Commissioners having attested and set apart to Margaret Bell, widow of Benj^r Bell dec^d one third in value according to our estimation of the lands and appurtenances of which the said Benj^r Bell died, seized & possessed, by leave to report. The whole tract contains by actual survey 154 acres as represented on the above plat, from which we set apart 30 acres as, and for her dower for life marked and bounded as follows. Beginning at a gum on the fluggy run Swamp thence $\text{S } 25^{\circ} \text{ W } 58$ poles to the road leading from Jordan to South Quay thence along said road $\text{S } 35^{\circ} \text{ E } 70$ poles to the gate post thence at $\text{S } 15^{\circ} \text{ E } 14$ poles to a peach tree on the yard near the dwelling house thence at $\text{S } 22^{\circ} \text{ E } 34$ poles to a pine at the run of the fluggy run Swamp thence up said run the several courses thereof to the beginning containing 30 acres as aforesaid which we estimate having regard to quality as well as quantity to be one third part thereof.
