Worrell so as reasonable losses on one third of the tract of land referred to in the bill of the complainant as after giving one months notice of the place and day of sale by striking up a convenient road or convenient public places or places - the said Commissioners shall also furnish bidding auction on a credit of twelve months, except so much as may be sufficient to carry the same into which shall be for cast, the kind of land of which Supt. Worrell died seized and possessed, which by last Will and Testament he devised to the complainants. And make report of the same in order to a final decree.

On the motion of James Gardner Ordered that one of the Commissioners of the Court will take and settle an account of said Gardner's administration on the estate of James Gardner and make report thereof to Court -
