

On motion of Samuel Bailey against Thomas J. Foster to show cause why the Indictment of William R. and Madeline M. Bailey should not be returned. This day came the parties by their attorneys appearing fully heard, it is considered by the Court that the said motion be denied, and that the said pay to the defendant his costs, about his defense in this behalf suffered.

Ordered that George D. Gray, Isaac Little, William S. Debrill and William H. Ableson among those of them charged to the Court undertake the rebuilding of George bridge, near the town of Completed, and make report thereof to Court.

Edgar Oshes & Joseph H. Morrill infants of tender years by Lebbeus D. Edwards their next friend against Isaac Warner executor of Isaac Morrill dec'd.

This cause was docketed and came on to be heard by consent of parties and was argued by counsel: On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that Benjamin D. Pope and Thomas Morrill commissioners lawfully appointed for that purpose, any two of whom may act, shall proceed to assign Richard Morrill eldest of Isaac Morrill dec'd his reasonable share in one third of the tract of land referred to in the bill of the complainant as after giving one months notice of the place and day of sale by sticking up advertisements in some convenient public place or places - the said Commissioners shall also proceed to sell at public auction on a credit of twelve months, except so much as may be sufficient to carry this decree into effect which shall be for cash, the tract of land of which Isaac Morrill dec'd was seized and possessed, and which by last Will and Testament he devised to the complainant. And make report of their proceedings in order to a final decree.

On the motion of James Andrews Ordered that one of the Commissioners of this Court ask State and Sells an account of said Andrews administration in the estate of John Andrews and make report thereof to Court.

An account of Davis Morrill accidental proceedings on the estate of Colin Davis dec'd was returned and ordered to lie on the Court for exceptions.

William A. Jones is appointed Surveyor of the road leading from the sign post at the S. end to the flat Swamp bridge in the town of John Gray removed, and it is ordered that the said bounds work thereof.

James H. Dykes nephew of James H. Dykes dec'd with the approbation of the Court made John Dykes for his guardian and thereupon the said John Dykes with G. D. Dorrance and W. Gray his servants entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of three hundred dollars conditioned according to law.
