

Ordered against me until paid for the widow Susan Lamb's share \$197.52<sup>78</sup>  
Annual to be divided between the Children \$935.25<sup>78</sup>.

for this amount I took eight equal bonds from the widow Susan Lamb, with John M. Greeley as her security, one of which I assigned to Joseph D. Davis in right of his wife, due to Susan Lamb as the guardian ad lass of Theodore, Nathaniel, Sarah Robins, John Beard and William D. Lamb and the other I.

On the auction of James M. Greeley guardianship to the orphans of George Woodard dec'd. Ordered that he be allowed to expend the sum of ten dollars out of the principal of each of his wards estate for their support &c.

For reasons appearing to the Court. Ordered that the Overseers of the poor land Distress of Henry Warren foreclose to Thomas Kitchen according to law the said Kitchen to pay four dollars annually for the service of said Distress.

On the instant of Nathaniel D. Bryant who made oath and testified with John M. Greeley & Lewis D. Bryant his brothers interest unto and acknowledged a bond for the sum of ten thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificated a grant of him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Caleb Everett dec'd. in due form.

Ordered that Alexander Myrick, Israel Barrell, James Magot and Thomas D. Howell or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appear at the personal estate of Caleb Everett dec'd and return the aforesaid under their hands to Court.

Ordered that Isaac Turner, Jr. be except from the payment of taxes if for failure to bring aged and infirm.

Ordered that the Overseers of the poor land Jane and Richard children of Henry Buck go to Thomas J. Trotter according to law be paying ten dollars annually until he pays the sum of fifty dollars for each.

On the instant of Susan Lamb guardianship. Ordered that she as guardian to allow to expend or obtain sixty dollars out of the principal of her Ward Mrs. Lamb's estate. One hundred dollars of the principal of her ward Catherine's estate. Ninety dollars of her wife Sally's estate, and eighty dollars of each of her wards, John W. Evans & William D. Lamb's estate for their education and support.

An Inventory and Apportionment of the estate of James F. Moore dec'd was returned and ordered to be recorded.

The account current and Commissioners report of Leslie D. Andrus' guardianship of Margaret and George Lawrence was returned and ordered to be recorded.

William J. Barrell is appointed Surveyor of the road in the place of Caleb Everett deceased and it is ordered that the usual bonds do record thereto.
