for this amount I took eight equal bonds from the purchaser Susan Lamb, with John M. Gentry as her security, one of which I assigned to Joseph D Davis on right of his wife, due to Susan Lamb as the guardian of late of Frederick, Nathaniel, Sarah Robson, John Beard and William D Lamb and the late J.

On the motion of John M Gentry guardian to the orphans of James Woodard dec^d. Ordered that he be allowed to expend the sum of ten dollars out of the principal of each of his wards estate for their support &c

For reasons appearing to the Court Ordered that the Overseers of the poor bond Dick and of Henry Brown pay wages to Thomas Robinson according to Law the said Robinson to pay several dollars annually for the services of said Dick.

On the motion of Nathaniel D Wagners who made oath and together with John M Gentry & James D Wagners has been introduced into and acknowledged a bond on the penalty of ten thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Caleb Overalls dec^d on due proof.

Ordered that Alexander Myrick, Jacob Barnwell, James Magot and Thomas D Howell or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Caleb Overalls dec^d and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

Ordered that James Turner, Jr. be exempt from the payment of taxes if for future he being aged and infirm.

Ordered that the Overseers of the poor bond Lane and Richards children of Henry Buck pay to Thomas J Dwyer according to Law the paying ten dollars annually until he pays the sum of fifty dollars for each.

On the motion of Susan Lamb guardian Ordered that she as guardian be allowed to expend or obtain sixty dollars out of the principal of her Ward Thers Lumber estate. One hundred dollars of the principal of her Ward Nathaniel's estate. Ninety dollars of her wards Sally's estate, and eighty dollars of each of her wards, John M Susan & William D Lamb's estate for their education and support.

An Inventory and Appraisement of the estate of James J Moore dec^d was returned and ordered to be recorded.

The account current and Commissioners report of Elizabeth Dandies guardianship of Margaret and George Lawrence was returned and ordered to be recorded.

William D Barnwell is appointed surveyor of the road in the place of Caleb Barnwell deceased and it is ordered that the usual bonds do reach thereof.
