Ordered that the portion of the road of which Joshua Peifer is surveyor be extended to Branch's bridge across Decatur Swamp.

Ordered that William S. Godfrey, Edward H. Maybury, C. A. W. Atkinson and J. Makore or any three of them do let to the lowest undertaker the repair of the roadway around the public square, receive the same when completed and make report to the court.

Ordered that the hands of George B. Cole do work on the road of which the said Joshua Peifer is surveyor.

William D. Westcott is appointed surveyor of the road from the forks of the river meeting house to Dr. A. G. Davis' in the room of Mr. A. Jones deceased, and it is ordered that the usual hands do work thereon.

Ordered that Edwin Garrison, Henry Steggins, A. J. Smith & Mallory & Pittman or any three of them, let to the lowest undertaker the conserving & repair of the roadway leading to Cherry Grove Ferry - receive the same when completed and make report to the court.

Ordered that the Sheriff be restrained from paying William Remond the sum of \$100 the amount due amount owing for hire at June Court last for opening a new road for a sum of \$20 being part of the way to hire at June Court for conducting break bridge - the further order of the court.

Theodore Ivory Scott is appointed surveyor of the road leading from Berlin to the road in the room of Francis P. Butts deceased and it is ordered that the usual hands do work thereon.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow morning nine o'clock
