Ordered that the hands of Herongate B. Cole do work on the roads of which the said Cole is Surveyor.

William B. Westbrook is appointed Surveyor of the road from the forks of the road near the meeting house to Dr. A. G. Christ in the town of W. A. Lane assessed, and it is ordered that the usual hands do work thereon.

Ordered that Edwin Harrison, Henry Higgins & T. Smith & Chas. E. Brown or any three of them, let to the lowest undertaker the mowing of the road from Southway to Cherry Grove ferry—receive the same when completed and make report to the Court.

Ordered that the Sheriff be restrained from paying William Bonner the sum of \$100 the amount the amount owed for hire at June Court last for opening a new road the sum of \$20 being part of the levy to have at June Court for rebuilding Swanton bridge in the further order of the Court.

Theodore Tracy is appointed Surveyor of the road leading from Boston to the Court in the town of Francis P. Bull's lot and it is ordered that the usual hands do work thereon.
