

On the motion of Isaac Bessette. Ordered that one of the Commissioners of this Court do this settle and adjust an account of said Bessette's guardianship of Anne Pope and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that the account of William Morfa installle amounting to \$1.68 be laid before the Court of Public accounts for his examination and payment.

John R. Kelly, who has been duly licensed to practice shalloe in the Courts of this Commonwealth, his motion was leave to practice in this Court and shalloe be took the oath of Kelly & the Commonwealth and the oath of an attorney at law.

William Sanford is appointed Surveyor of the new road beginning at Laurel Swamp and extending to the dyke foot at Lenois on the Smithfield road. And it is ordered that the land of James C. On motion of John Vick. Ordered that one of the Commissioners of this Court do this settle and adjust an account of said Vick's administration on the estate of Mary Ann Vick and make report thereof to Court.

By consent the license granted John P. Jenkins to sell goods if at Shenandoah transferred to John Pomer according to law.

On motion of Horat J. Davis. Ordered that the Commissioners in the last year Davis's Guardianship of the orphans of James C. Harrison do allow the last guardian to pay out of the principal of the wards estate an amount sufficient to cover the expense of holding a Surpassing of said records.

Joseph Edwin Fells who stands bound by recognizance for his appearance here to answer the complaint of Rebecca Turner against him for a breach of the peace this day appeared in discharge of his recognizance. Whereupon the said Rebecca Turner and sundry steps were taken and returned and the said Joseph Edwin Fells by his attorney fully paid the Court after hearing the various debts ordered that the said Joseph Edwin Fells do take recognizance himself in the sum of fifty dollars with four shillings in the sum of one dollar and fifty cents each conditioned for his keeping the peace towards the Commonwealth and all its citizens for the term of twelve months and that he also pay the cost of his prosecution. Whereupon the said Joseph Edwin Fells together with Joseph P. Lee, Obadiah L. Simmons, William C. Wommack and Francis Fells his co-defendants severally acknowledged themselves to owe to the Commonwealth of Virginia each and every of them the sum of fifty dollars and the said Joseph Edwin Fells the sum of one dollar and fifty cents each, of their respective goods and chattels, lands and tenements to be levied for the use of the Commonwealth and that if the said Joseph Edwin Fells shall keep the peace towards the Commonwealth and all its citizens and pay the costs of the said Rebecca Turner for the term of twelve months from this day then his recognizance is to be void or else to remain in full force.
