And that said Commissioners make report to Court of their proceedings in order to a final decree.

On the motion of Robert Rowland who made oath and together with William Evans and Charles W. Bachman his deponents entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Two hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs, certified a printed bill for claiming letters of administration on the estate of Louis Rice as in default.

Ordered that James C. Peters, John Williams, Joel Evans and William Evans, a majority of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose to appear at the personal estate of Louis Rice dec'd and return the aforesaid documents under their hands to Court.

On motion William Evans. Ordered that he be exempt from the payment of taxes of Court in future being aged and infirm.
