

On the motion of Arthur Whitehead executor of James Whitehead dec^d. Ordered that Goodwin & Griffin who have heretofore appointed a Special Commission for the purpose, do settle and adjust an account of the Arthur Whitehead's administration on his estate as in and under report thereof to Court.

For reasons appearing to the Court. Ordered that Dick Warron free himself to land by the Overseeers of the Poor to Henry Kitchin according to law, the paying the sum of four dollars annually for the service of said apprentice.

The last Will and Testament of James O'Brien deceased was proved by the oath of Thomas A. Hery and Edward W. Hapfenburg one of the subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of Thomas O'Brien the executor thereto made oath and together with William C. Gay and John A. Butler his decessor's executor entered into and acknowledged a bond on the penalty of fifteen hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said will as before.

On the motion of Samuel Prudden who made oath and together with Henry W. Gay and John J. Branch his decessor's executor entered into and acknowledged a bond on the penalty of ten thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Joseph Prudden dec^d in due form.

It is ordered to be certified that it has been proven to the satisfaction of the Court that Thomas Nelson who is so reputed and believed was a private in the office of the Revolution is dead leaving the children Ben, John, William, John Nelson and ^{Samuel} Nelson who are the only heirs at law for Thomas Nelson dec^d.

On the motion of William D. Merrill. Ordered that the estate of Thomas Nelson dec^d be committed to the hands of Jacob Barnes Sheriff for administration according to law.

On motion of Jacob Weston. Ordered that William D. Hook be appointed Special Commissioner to settle and adjust an account of said Weston's administration on the estate of Jacob Weston dec^d and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that Richard Barrett W. A. Hapfenburg of Newbury do let to the land undertakes the building of a bridge across Cedar Swamp reverse the same when completed and make report thereof to Court.

On the motion of Henry Kitchin who made oath and together with A. J. Hapfenburg and Samuel D. Kelle his decessor's executor entered into and acknowledged a bond on the penalty of five hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Thomas Kitchin dec^d in due form.

On the motion of Oliver A. Hery. Ordered that James D. Rogers who is appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose do settle and adjust an account of said Hery's administration on the estate of Benjamin Hery dec^d and make report thereof to the Court.
