This day this cause came on to be heard by counsel on the bill and answer and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge order and direct that William J. Herring who is hereby appointed a special Commissioner of this Court, after advertising the time & place of sale for twenty days at the Courthouse and at two or more public places in the vicinity of the land mentioned in the bill proceed to sell the said land subject to the widow right of dower, to the highest bidder and that he receive so much in cash as will pay the expenses of the dower, and for the balance of the proceeds of sale he take equal bonds payable in nine months with good security - that he retain one hundred dollars out of James A. and one to Martha J. Herring that he assign five of the said bonds to the guardian ad litem of Charles R. John R. Starfield & Anna Renn and that he assign the remaining one to the guardian ad litem of Holly & Ann Eliza Britt, and report to this Court in order to a final decree.
