By consent of parties this day the cause came on to be heard upon the bill and answer and was argued by Counsel. Upon the hearing of which the Court with the aid of the Commissioners who after having given due notice of the time and place of sale of the tract of land called piney grove containing about 240 acres - one half of the purchase money cash and the balance on a credit of twelve months and after paying the costs of this decree and the sale, the balance of the purchase money divide into the equal parts giving unto Charles Knight three sixths to Martha Merrill one sixth to Henry Merrill one sixth and the remaining sixth to Isabella Merrill. And make up to the Court in order to a final decree.

The Commissioners on this cause this day made a report which is as their words are "Pursuant to the annexed decree the undersigned Commissioners have sold to the highest bidder on a credit of six months the tracts of land mentioned in the said decree unto Martha Merrill because the purchaser, for which she gave for the tract containing 80 acres \$89.00 and for the tract containing 27 1/2 acres 42 dollars 25 cents making \$131.25 for the two parcels of land. We have deducted from that amount the sum of \$17.50 for expenses attending sale of said land which leaves a balance of \$113.75 and we have also taken four bonds as directed by said decree which is as follows to wit: We have taken four bonds in lieu of her dowry the sum of eight dollars and fifty cts. one bond assigned and paid to John Knapplet for \$21.69 cents, to Sepe Brown on right of his wife \$21.69 cents to the infant Leman Turner \$21.69 cents, which makes the original amount of \$113.75 all of which we humbly submit to this Court. Given under our hands this 21st day of March 1847. Benjamin C Waller, John Klutshand, Peter Edwards."

An Inventory and Appraisement and account of sales of the estate of Elizabeth Merrill dec^d was returned and ordered to be recorded.

The Commissioners appointed to view and report to the Court the propriety of raising a road across the Cedar Swamp this day made their report. Whereupon it is ordered that James Knapplet, Richard Parrell and William A. Mapson be appointed Commissioners to view and report to the Court the propriety of building a bridge across the Cedar Swamp, receive the same when completed and make up thereof to the Court.

The Commissioners appointed to let to the lowest undertaker the rebuilding of the mill race at the Cypress bridge this day made their report.

An Inventory and Appraisement of the estate of Joel A. Edwards was returned and ordered to be recorded.
