attorneys who being fully heard, and the evidence adduced considered. It is considered by the court that
the Indenture entered into on the 26th day of May 1841 between Bennett & Whitfield and
William W. Estler two of the Overseers of the Poor of the one part and Benjamin C. Vick of the other
part by which Hannah and Richard Estlers of the said Gillie A. Brown, Esq; be, and they are
hereby cancelled and annulled. And that the said Benjamin C. Vick pay to the said Gillie A. Brown
her costs by her in this behalf expended.

Ordered that the presentment of the Grand Jury this day made against Bennett Dugay for unlaw-
fully stabbing a negro slave Daniel the property of Marion D. Moore be certified to a Justice of the
Peace to be presented upon according to law.
