On consideration whereof the Court doth order adjudge and decree that Thomas B. Powell be appointed a Commissioner of this Court who be empowered after advertising the time and place of sale at three or more public places in the County, to sell to the highest bidder the slaves estate of Mrs. Mary Bennett, in the future to rent the real estate on a credit of twelve months and the slaves on credit of her and except for example to pay taxes - after paying the taxes of the slaves he is to take back and then in the following proportionate taxes. Divide into two shares of equal amounts as follows. First Share \$60. divide into three equal shares and assign one to Walter Myrick, spouse of James Bennett and to Isabell Barnes or right of his wife and the other share to be guardian ad litem of Benjamin Bennett - 2^d Share \$60. to be sold by Commissioner in full decree and divided accordingly. 3^r Share \$60. the last for land to Joseph Bell and his negro slaves to Mary Bennett. The balance to Joseph Bennett. 4^t Share \$60. to be sold by right of his wife one third of negro slaves. It is done as above directed. 5th Share \$60. to Bell & Co. in right of his wife - one third of negro slaves to widow or 6th. To Mary Bennett infant of Bennett in order to a final decree.
