

On the motion of Lemuel Wells guardian of Benjamin Bunnell. Ordered that he be allowed to expend out of the principal of his wards estate the sum of fifty dollars for her education and support

On the motion of Robert S Barnes guardian of the estates of Henry & Stephen. Ordered that he be allowed to expend out of the principal of his wards estate the sum of seven dollars each for each of the years 1822. 26 & 27 for their support &c

On motion of Robert S Barnes. Ordered that Thomas D. Merrill and Alexander Maynard, who are hereby appointed Special Commissioners for the purpose, do take, settle and adjust an account of said Barnes' guardianship of the estates of Henry & Stephen and make report thereof to Court.

Benjamin C. Pope guardian of Sarah Anne Foster this day returned an account of the profits of his said wards estate, which is ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of Olga Gray widow of Joseph Gray deceased. Ordered that Henry Kimball, Richard Dardow, Thomas D Knight and Benjamin C. Pope or any three of them do appraise and appraise to the said Olga Gray one third in value of the real estate of which her said husband died seized as shown therein and make report thereof to Court

On motion of William Edwards guardian of Louisa Vaughan. Ordered that he be allowed to expend out of the principal of his said wards estate the sum of fifty dollars for her support &c

For reasons appearing to the Court It is ordered that James C. Peters and Alexander R. Cole, Thomas Wrenn John J. P. Farrington, Samuel Parkhurst & Kimball Dolbe are any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the peace for that purpose, do use the way for opening a new road from Peters road to Bliss mill road, and report to the Court the convenience and necessary expenses which will result as well be certain roads as to the parties in case the said road be opened or proposed.

Stephen Dardow Just this day produced to the Court a certificate under the hand of the Governor of this Commonwealth with the seal of the Commonwealth therein affixed whereby he is commissioned to execute the office of Sheriff of this County until the first December term of this Court for the next year. and thereupon the said Stephen Dardow with Wm J. Seabell Wm H. Nicholas Daniel & Drury Cole, Robert Ricks, John M. Gurley and William R. Edwards his securities entered into and acknowledged three several bonds in the penalty of thirty thousand dollars each conditioned according to law, which bonds are ordered to be recorded, and the said Stephen Dardow took the oath of fidelity to the Commonwealth, the oath against duelling, the oath to support the constitution of the United States, and the oath of office.

On the motion of Joseph Drury who made oath and together with Arthur A Drury and Samuel Wells his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs to perform as granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of William Drury deceased as the law.

Ordered that Benjamin F. Houghland, William J. Seabell and Jesse Little being first duly sworn before a Justice of the peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of William Drury dec'd and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.
