doth adjudge, order and direct that Thomas D. Morrell and John E. Peeler be appointed Com-
missioners for the purpose of selling to the highest bidder the lands of the late Polly Story upon
the following terms. so much cash as may be necessary to pay the costs of this suit. The balance
on a credit of nine months. And they take bonds as follows. one bond for one fifth and a p[er]c[e]nt
of the same to Elizabeth Story, one for one fifth and a p[er]c[e]nt of the same to Jane Holt, one for one
seventh of one fifth and a p[er]c[e]nt of the same to Thomas A. Story, one for like amount and a p[er]c[e]nt
of the same to Benjamin E. Daugherty in right of his wife, one for same amount and a p[er]c[e]nt to
Eldridge D. A. Clary in right of his wife, one for same amount and a p[er]c[e]nt to Helen Edwards in
right of his wife, one for same amount and a p[er]c[e]nt to D. T. Lyles in right of his wife,
one for same amount and a p[er]c[e]nt to Henry Story in right of his wife, and another for same
amount and a p[er]c[e]nt to Samuel Story (heirs of Sife Story) one bond for one third of one fifth
and a p[er]c[e]nt of the same to William C. Wilson, one for same amount and a p[er]c[e]nt to Polly Ferguson,
one for same amount and a p[er]c[e]nt of the same to Jonathan Darden guardian of Martha E.
& Rebekah C. Wilson (heirs of Margaret Wilson) one bond for 1/6 of 1% and a p[er]c[e]nt to Robert L.
Story, one for same amount and a p[er]c[e]nt to Elizabeth Williams in right of his wife, one for same
amount and a p[er]c[e]nt to George Moore in right of his wife, one for same amount and a p[er]c[e]nt to
Elizabeth A. Story, one for same amount and a p[er]c[e]nt to guardian of Benjamin F. Story, and
one other bond same amount and a p[er]c[e]nt to the guardian of Dennis F. Story. And it is
further ordered that the family burying ground and a right of way thereat be reserved. And
it is further ordered that the bills to the land be withheld till the purchase money is all
paid. And said Commissioners are ordered to report to this Court in order to a final decree.
