William Barrett orphan of Parker Barrett with the approbation of the Court made choice of Mr. P. Britt for his guardian and thereupon the said Caleb D. Park with James Mayot and John E. Beale his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of fifteen hundred dollars conditioned according to law -

On the motion of Zachariah Story who made oath and together with Thomas D. Howell and John E. Beale his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certificatoe is granted him for attorney & fees of administration on the estate of Polly Story due and due found.

Ordered that Robert J. Barnes, Thomas D. Howell, Miles Story and John E. Beale or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appear at all the personal winter of Polly Story dec'd and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

On the motion of Bryant Holland Ordered that the execution of Ga. Ga. spcll from the office on the 1st day of January 1848 upon a Judgment obtained in this court in favor of Lucinda Daugherty against Harrison Harvey and Bryant Holland &c and the same is hereby quashed.

It is ordered to be certified that it has been proven to the satisfaction of the Court that Thomas Weston who still represented and believed was a private in the war of the Revolution is dead leaving the following children to wit Joshua Weston, Benjamin Weston and Holliday Weston and a grand-daughter to wit Mary Foster daughter of Linda Foster formerly Weston, who are the only heirs at law of the said Thomas Weston dec'd.

The registers of Amanda Dardis, Betsy Atlie, Hannah Ann Evans, Henrietta Atlie, Lucy Atlie, Adeline Atlie and Murdoch Joyner for expenses were examined and certified to be truly made.

A Deed of bargain and sale from Mary Barrett to Martha Barrett was produced in Court and Caleb Everett one of the subscribing witnesses to said deed being dead deceased by sign and Benjamin Barrett the other two witnesses to said deed being deceased likewise and by sign the name of the said Caleb Everett is the said deed subscribed as in the proper handwriting of the said Caleb Everett and that he signed the same in that premises and at the time that the said Barrett & Myrick subscribed their names as witnesses to the said deed. But the said deed having been before proved by the wife of the said Alexander Myrick & Benjamin Barrett is ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term - The minutes of the foregoing proceedings were signed by a Notary Public
