

of the first bond executed by the said Barnwell and conditioned according to law. And the said Barnwell refusing to give the said security it is ordered that his powers & duties as guardian of said bonds be revoked and annulled.

Benjamin Barnwell nephew of Parker Barnwell with the approbation of the Court made choice of John E. Deale for his guardian and thereupon the said Eliza D. Barnwell with James Mayfield and John E. Deale his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of fifteen hundred dollars conditioned according to law.

On the motion of Zachariah Story who made oath and together with Thomas D. Barnwell and John E. Deale his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs with reference to grounds then for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Polly Story deceased.

Ordered that Robert J. Barnes, Thomas D. Barnwell, Miles Story and John E. Deale or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose to appraise all the personal estate of Polly Story deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

On the motion of Dryand Holland. Ordered that the execution of Geo. W. Spurr from the office on the 18th day of January 1845 upon a Judgment obtained in the Court in favour of Lucretia C. Daugherty against Harrison Murray and Dryand Holland be and the same is hereby quashed.

It is ordered to be certified that it has been proven to the satisfaction of the Court that Thomas Weston who is represented and believed was a private in the war of the Revolution is dead leaving the leaving the following children to wit Joshua Weston, Benjamin Weston and Melviny Weston and a grand-daughter to wit Mary Foster daughter of Linda Foster formerly Weston, who are the only heirs at law of the said Thomas Weston deceased.

The registers of Amanda Dardow, Nancy Arlie, Hannah Ann Evans, Henrietta Arlie, Mary Scott, Adeline Arlie, and Meredeth Joynes, free negroes, were examined and certified to be truly made.

A Deed of bargain and sale from Mary Barnwell to Martha Barnwell was presented in Court and Caleb Corwell one of the subscribing witnesses to said deed being dead called in his wife and Benjamin Barnwell the other two witnesses to said deed being absent, before me they did the name of the said Caleb Corwell to the said deed subscribed as in the proper form and writing of the said Caleb Corwell and that he signed the same in their presence and at the time that the said Barnwell & Melviny subscribed their names as witnesses to the said deed. And the said deed having been before passed by the vote of the said Alexander & Melviny of Benjamin Barnwell is ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
