The Commissioners within cause this day made their report whereas on the 20th inst. of the term of the County Court of Southampton dated February Court 1847 and amended March Court 1847 and again amended December Court 1847 after giving legal notice of the time and place of sale. I sold to the highest bidder on the 20 day of January 1848 the tract of land of which Martha Darrell dec^d possessed containing by estimation nearly one acre more or less on a tract of twelve acres, and Benjamin T Darrell became purchaser for the sum of three hundred and twenty four dollars. Also sold at the same time and place on the same terms in conjunction with Thos B Worrell become appraised by another decree of the Court to sell the lower land and negroes of the said Mary Darrell, the said Martha Darrell interest in her mother's lower land being one sixth part and the said Benjamin T Darrell also became the purchaser of the whole lower land for the sum of One thousand five hundred and five dollars. 76 part of which is \$258.93 which added to \$224.00 makes \$574.93 1/2 the amount of the real estate of said Martha Darrell dec^d for which sum I have taken bonds from said Benj T Darrell and David Barnes his securities payable the 20 day of January 1849 and paid Walter Myrick in right of his wife \$95.00

I have also in conjunction with Thomas B Worrell become as aforesaid at the same time and place Sold to the highest bidder said Martha Darrell interest in her mother's lower negroes the sales of said negroes who were sold and delivered according to \$600.00 as well as per Thomas B Worrell's report, on sixth part of which is \$1015.95 which added to \$1121.30 makes \$2137.25 the net sales negroes from which deduct 75 of \$1015.95 which is \$2121 30 for Mrs Mary Darrell which I have paid over to her, leaves \$2204.39 from which sum deduct for myself as agent \$20.00 for Lawyer & Clerk \$12.00 also the term of \$2.50 do not as admr. of said Martha Darrell December 31 1847 leaves \$2172.89 of which sum I have paid Mrs Mary Darrell 162 50
