An inventory and appraisement of the estate of Daniel H. Dwyer dec^d was returned, and ordered to be recorded.

William S. Stephenson an insolvent debtor now on custody under an execution at the suit of Walter Maynard administrator of Anthony Muller dec^d was this day brought into Court and submitted and delivered in a schedule of his estate and made oath thereto according to law. Whereupon it is ordered that the said Stephenson be discharged from custody if delivered from debt unless there be a return of default.

On the motion of William Edwards who made oath and together with George H. Gardner and William Dwyer his co-defendants entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificate granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Sam Edwards deceased in due form.

Ordered that William L. Edwards, James Manfau and James D. McSperry being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose, do appraise all the personal estate of Sam Edwards deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and it appearing to the Court that the defendant both had legal notice of this motion he was solemnly called but came not. Therefore it is awarded by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the defendant forty five dollars and fifty five cents (the amount paid by the plaintiff as security for the defendant in discharge of - J. S. Mahmel in a bond, entered on this bond in favor of James D. McSperry executor of Stephen H. Dwyer dec^d) with legal interest.
