This day this cause comes on to be heard by court on the bill and answer and in support
counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that said Thomas Borth
who is hereby appointed a Special Commissioner of this Court, after giving reasonable notice of the
time and place of sale by advertisement at two or more public places in the county of the
