This day serves the parties by their attorneys and on the motion of the Defendant the case is continued till the next Term.

Ordered that William & Stephenson Alfred J. Stephenson and Allen Edwards do let to the Court and make the report of the last general bridge across the same about completed and make report thereof to Court.
