Accordingly to the annexed decree we have proceeded to divide and allot the negroes before mentioned as is before stated. Viz. 1st In the heirs and distributees of James Gray do. and 2^d to the heirs and distributees of Mr. Gray do. after which we sold at public auction to the highest bidder after giving the required notice of the time and place of the sale the negroes allotted to the heirs and distributees of James Gray do. as is before stated. also the tract of land as is before stated.

The net proceeds of the sale of the said land and negroes have been divided and paid according to the conditions of the said decree as per receipts herewith returned. We divided the net proceeds into five parts as is above stated and paid one fifth to James Murfee in his own right & one fifth to him (J Murfee) as administrator of Drury Murfee do. one fifth to J. W. Murfee Esq. one fifth to the heirs of Richard Murfee do. The fifth allotted to the heirs of Richard Murfee do. we divided into five equal parts and paid one share to James Murfee grand of William Bell's estate named on the said decree, one share to James Murfee as administrator of Richard Murfee do. one share to William Murfee in his own right, one share to George W. Murfee in his own right and one share to Francis Murfee in his own right. We also subdivided the fifth allotted to the heirs of Barnwell Murfee into six equal shares, as above and paid one share to the Francis in right of Allen Murfee and three shares to him (A. Francis) as part of Mary, William, and John Murfee - one share to William in right of his wife a daughter one share to Geo. C. Lewis W. Bishop dying without issue having produced to us the certificate of having paid for the land we have therefore not made him a his heirs any title. Given under our hands this day of A. D. 1807.
