

By consent of parties Ordered that Sigs Drury is appointed Trustee as a surety of Bond executed by Thomas and John Ingers to James S. Williams in the place of John W. Hale having date the 25th of March 1842 and recorded in the Clerk's Office of this Court.

The Court doth assign Henry A. Hall guardian to Martha Hall widow of Allen Hall dec^d and though he together with David Bryant and Sarah J. Hall his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Two hundred dollars conditioned according to law.

On the motion of William J. Sebell. Ordered that Sethilton R. Edwards who is appointed trustee for the purpose of state settle and adjust an account of said Sebell's administration in the estate of Samuel Williams dec^d and make report thereof to Court.

On the motion of William J. Sebell. Ordered that Sethilton R. Edwards who is appointed trustee for the purpose of state settle and adjust an account of said Sebell's administration in the estate of Edwin Tompkins dec^d and make report thereof to Court.

On the motion of Harmon D. Moore. Ordered that one of the Commissioners of this Court do state settle and adjust an account of said Thomas guardianship of Eliza Bryant and make report thereof to Court.

For reasons appearing to the Court. Ordered that the Overseers of the poor do bind Josephus Leath child of Lucia Leath prisoner to Sigs Drury for negro according to law, he paying the mother of said child one dollar annually until he arrives to the age of twenty one years. March one of the Justices signing therefor.

On the motion of Caswell Morrell who made oath and together with Silas Ellsworth his security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of thirty dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration in the estate of Mary Doyal deceased in due form.
