Twenty Millions dollars and make report thereof to Court.

On the motion of Clement D. Moore. Ordered that one of the Commissioners of the Court do state  
settle and adjust an account of said Moore's guardianship of Eliza Bryant and make report thereof  
to Court.

For reasons appearing to the Court. Ordered that the Trustees of the poor de land, Sampson  
Hall child of Lucia Hall, pay negro to Jeptha Brown for negro according to law, be paying the  
mother of said child one dollar annually until he comes to the age of twenty one years. Name
