

(634) Editha A. R. Sommers caption of Recd. H. Lawrence directed with the approbation of
the Court made claim of William J. Schell for her guardian and therfore the said William J.
Schell with Edwards Park and Arthur W. Duryea his executors entered into an account,
owed a bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned according to law.

Ordered that Peter D. Williams, Richard Parker and Merrideth Hollands doth let the
Court understand the repairs of little bridges at old Saratoga run in the time when
completed and make report thereof to Court.

Thomas B. Worrell former James Davis, Benjamin C. Waller, John Stephenson, Fred
Worrell, Henry B. Vaughan, Oldfield Smith, Joel Brown, Arthur Middlemiss, Lewis
Griffen, George H. Gardner, Montague Bradburn, Jerry Dow, Gilbert Pond, Drew
Vaughn, Humphrey Stevens, Joseph L. Bennett, J. Griffen, Thomas Vaughan, and
William Cobb were sworn a grand jury of inquest for the body of this County and having
received their charge withdrew and after sometime returned into Court and presented
Oscar Spyry for an unlawful assault and battery on the person of Mills Spyry by hitting
him with a pistol on the ninth day of June 1858 in the County of Saratoga and as
the voluntary witness of the said Mills Spyry sworn in Court and sent to the grand jury.
James Clark, of James, for retaining ancient arms without a license in the County of Saratoga
assisted at different times in the latter part of the last and present year to Wm. Bond
and others by the information of said Daniel Bond for by the grand jury was sworn a fact
and the said grand jury bearing nothing further to present were discharged.

A writing bearing date the 28 day of April 1859 purporting the last will and Testament of John
Popel was produced in court for proved and there being but one subscriber witness to probate
and it appearing to the Court that the body of the said writing and signature tends to satisfy
the hand writing of the said Sampson Popel the Court refers to and the said paper writing is
record as the last Will and Testament of the said Sampson Popel. And on the motion of Col.
Williams who moved same and together with John Barnard and Elihu Popel & wife
entered into and acknowledged above in the penalty of One hundred dollars conditioned
as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the
estate of the Sampson Popel deceased in due form.

On the motion of Peter W. Ward. Ordered that James H. Schell out of the sum of
of his wife estate formerly William Stew pay to the said Peter W. Ward the sum
of two dollars and thirty cents.

On the motion of Samuel B. Ellis. Ordered that William D. Hood who is lawfully
appointed Commissioner for the purpose do state fully and adjust an account of said Ellis
administration on the estate of Polly Pond Esq and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that process issues against the persons thus day mentioned by the Court
