Whereupon it is ordered that the said writing be recorded as and for the last Will and testament of the said William A Spaulk deceased. And on the motion of John M. Gentry that several persons named who reads oath and together with H. Hancock D. Moore and John M. Gentry his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of twenty thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration of the said Will in due form.

Ordered that James D. McSpangenberg, H. Hancock, D. Moore, John M. Gentry, and Frederick Tubell any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do approve all the personal and real estate of William A Spaulk deceased and return the approval under their hands to Court.
